LOG LINE

When a nun in a remote convent claims immaculate conception, the Vatican sends a team of priests to investigate, concerned about an ancient prophecy that a woman will give birth to twin boys: one the Messiah, the other the Anti-Christ.

SHORT SYNOPSIS

According to an ancient prophecy, a woman will give birth to identical twin boys; one the Messiah, the other the Antichrist. After a Russian nun claims to have immaculately conceived twins, the Vatican sends a priest to investigate. There he discovers a secret society, Vox Dei, that plans to kill the Nun and her children.

DIRECTORS' STATEMENT

Deliver Us is a theological horror film that explores religious prophecies from various cultures throughout history. A universal thread in world religions is the story of feuding brothers: Cain and Abel, Thor and Loki, Set and Osiris, Zeus and Hades, and in our case Jesus and Lucifer. We center our story around identical twin brothers to tap into this cultural consciousness and to explore "the problem of evil"—the question of why a good and all-powerful God would permit the flourishing of evil. By presenting this existential dilemma within the horror genre, we aim to engage viewers on multiple levels to not just frighten but provide a thought-provoking experience.

ABOUT THE DIRECTORS

CRU ENNIS

Cru Ennis is an award-winning filmmaker, director, writer and producer that studied Theatrical Arts at the University of Arkansas to accompany degrees in Marketing and Finance. He is a founding member of World's Fair Pictures where he has produced several shorts and feature films in over twenty-two different countries around the world. He has a passion for films with a social conscience, notably *Boys of Abu Ghraib*, Executive Produced by Ed Zwick and Marshall Herskovitz and *Isolated Victim*, a film he produced with Saldana Productions, about child trafficking in Haiti. He is currently writing *Philly Sound*, a biographical musical drama about the rise and fall of Philadelphia International Records.

LEE ROY KUNZ

Lee Roy Kunz is a writer, director, actor from Denver, Colorado. He founded World's Fair pictures with Cru Ennis and Issac Bauman after dropping out of USC film school to direct his first feature film *A Beer Tale*. He is a graphic novelist and a musician, with the ability to play seven instruments, with a particular love for the guitar and American folk music. He is a Certified Cicerone, home-brewer, and all-around lover and expert on beer. In the vein of *Boyhood*, where the characters age with the story, Lee Roy has been shooting his second feature *Devil's Fruit* for the past twelve years. *Devil's Fruit* is set to be released in 2023.

ABOUT THE CAST

JAUNE KIMMEL

Born and raised in Estonia, working currently in Rakvere Theatre, Jaune is 28 years young, who loves music, nature, and other things creative. She has previously never been in a foreign feature film, but has done many short films with Baltic Media School with a variety of filmmakers from all over the globe.

THOMAS KRETSCHMANN

Thomas Kretschmann can be seen in Disney's highly anticipated feature film *Indiana Jones and the Dial of Destiny* opposite Harrison Ford, Phoebe Waller-Bridge and Mads Mikkelsen. Thomas recently wrapped a co-starring role in the Amazon Studios' feature film *Upgraded* opposite Marisa Tomei and will also soon be seen in the independent feature films *Cerberus*, opposite Kate Bosworth and World's Fair Pictures *Deliver Us*. He recently starred in Michael Samuel's BAFTA nominated independent feature *The Windermere Children* where he played the lead role of 'Oscar Friedmann'; and can recently be seen in the Showtime series *Penny Dreadful: City of Angels* and HBO's tentpole series *Westworld*.

On the feature side, Thomas appeared in the Michael Polish film *Axis Sally*, featuring Al Pacino. Previously, he starred opposite Daniel Radcliffe in Greg McLean's independent feature *Jungle* and appeared in the Epix series *Berlin Station*. Kretschmann starred opposite Emily Blunt in 2009's *The Young Victoria*. Additional memorable performances in feature films include *Avengers: Age of Ultron, U-571, Central Intelligence, King Kong, Valkyrie, Wanted, Transsiberian, Eichmann, Grimm Love, Blade II and the Oscar winning film <i>The Pianist*. A gifted voice actor as well, Thomas lent his voice to the role of 'Professor Zündapp' in Disney Pixar's *Cars 2*.

He has had an extensive career in Europe, starring in multiple films and television series over the last four decades. Most recently he can be seen in the German television series *Biohackers* and *Das Boot*. His earlier film *Stalingrad* was one of the highest grossing ever Russian films. He can also be seen opposite Daniel Bruhl, Vera Farmiga, and John Malkovich in the Russian-

British drama In Transit. Additional European film credits include Ballon, Mogadishu, Grimm Love, Der Untergang, Immortal New York: 2095 and My Father - Rua Alguem 5555.

Thomas is internationally renowned and has worked with iconic directors including Peter Jackson, Roman Polanski and Guillermo Del Toro.

Maria Vera Ratti

Maria Vera Ratti was born September 26, 1994 in Avellino, Italy and was raised in Naples. She is an actress, known for *Il Commissario Ricciardi* (2021), Sabato, Domenica e Lunedì (2021) and I Bastardi di Pizzofalcone 3 (2021) and studied Russian and Central Asian Studies at Leiden University in Holland. After graduating in 2017, she was accepted to Italy's oldest national film school Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia, where many of Italy's leading actors were trained - such as Sophia Loren and Marcello Mastroianni. After her first year in drama school, Maria Vera booked her first role in a television series, where she played the daughter of a Neapolitan mafia boss. Soon afterwards she was the female lead in the Italian television series Il Commissario Ricciardi which was one of the most popular series released that year. Soon after Maria Vera began working nonstop and was the female lead in the third season of I Bastardi di Pizzofalcone. In 2021 she was cast as the Mona Lisa in the television series Leonardo, based on Leonardo da Vinci's life. She then took on the role of 'Giulianella', directed by award-winning director Edoardo de Angelis in his film Sabato, Domenica e Lunedì - a remake of Eduardo de Filippo's original theatre play aimed for the screen. She then played 'Giuliana' in the Netflix series The Lying Life of Adults, based off Elena Ferrante's book and directed by Edoardo de Angelis. The characters played by Maria Vera rarely resemble each other and she looks quite different in each production. She likes to work with different accents and languages and is fluent in both Italian and English. Maria Vera is represented by the Italian talent agency Volver Actor where her agents are Gianni Chiffi and Consuelo de Andreis.

Alexander Siddig

Alexander Siddig's career of quality acting in both film and TV spans well over three decades. He has played iconic characters and series regulars on shows such as *Gotham* and *Star Trek: Deep Space Nine* amongst many others. Other recent TV credits include *FOUNDATION* (Apple TV+) *The Spy* (Netflix), *Game of Thrones* (HBO), *Peaky Blinders* (Netflix), *Deep State* (Epix), and *The Kennedys: After Camelot* (Netflix). Siddig's film credits range from Oscar winning *Syriana*, *Clash of The Titans* and *The Fifth Estate* to more recent projects such as *21 Bridges* and *Skylines*. Siddig recently starred in the Apple TV+ series *Shantaram* released in October, 2022. He plays 'Khader Khan' opposite Charlie Hunnam.
